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VEST · TWIN 50G & TWIN 25G
Design 47 – Filati Journal 62

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Size 36 (38/40)

Instructions are given for smaller size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given, it applies to both sizes.

Materials: **100 (100, 150) g** of Lana Grossa **Twin 50g** (46% baby alpaca, 45% Merino wool, 9% polyamide; 85 m/50 g) in Red/Wine/Pink/Blue Grey/Petrol (**col 207**) and **25 (50, 50) g** of Lana Grossa **Twin 25g** (37% baby alpaca, 37% Merino wool, 26% polyamide; 200 m/25 g) in Red/Pink/Light Blue/Grey Blue/Rust/Camel (**col 107**). Size 8 mm needles; size 4.5 mm crochet hook.

Slip stitch rib: Multiple of 2 + 1 + 2 selvage sts. **Row 1 (WS):** Selvage st, * k1, p1; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, selvage st. **Row 2 (RS):** Selvage st, * p1, sl 1 pwise wyib; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, selvage st. Rep rows 1 and 2 for slip st rib. Work 12 rows with Twin 50g, 6 rows with Twin 25g alternately throughout.

Garter st: K every row.

Selvage sts: On every row: Knit first and last st.


Full-fashion decrease: At beg of RS row, selvage st, 3 sts in garter st, k2tog; at end of RS row, work to last 6 sts, skp, 3 sts in garter st, selvage st.

Gauge: 9 sts and 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm in slip st rib on size 8 mm needles.

Back: With size 8 mm needles and Twin 50g, cast on 41 (45, 49) sts. Work in slip st rib until piece meas 23 (24, 25) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 3 (4, 5) RS rows = 35 (37, 39) sts. Maintaining garter st edging, cont until piece meas 48 (49, 50) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 9 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 1 st 1 time and when piece meas 2 cm from beg of neck shaping, bind off rem 10 (11, 12) sts for each shoulder.

Front: Work same as back until piece meas 39 (40, 41) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 7 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 1 st at each neck edge 4 times and when same length as back to shoulders, bind off rem 10 (11, 12) sts for each shoulder.


Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder and side seams. **Neck and armhole edging:** With size 4.5 mm crochet hook and Twin 50g, rev sc around neck edge and each armhole edge.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
