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# JACKET · TWIN 50G

Design 48 – Filati Journal 62

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**Size** 36 (38/40)

Instructions are given for smaller size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given, it applies to both sizes.

**Materials:** 300 (350, 400) g of Lana Grossa **Twin 50g** (46% baby alpaca, 45% Merino wool, 9% polyamide; 85 m/50 g) in Light Green/Dark Green/Red/Orange/Dark Red/Dark Brown (col 202). Size 7 and 8 mm needles; three 22 mm buttons in dark green.

**Rib patt:** K1, p1.

**St st:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Rev St st:** P on RS, k on WS.

**Selvage sts:** On every row: Knit first and last st.

**Two-stitch selvage:** On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

**Full-fashion decrease:** At beg of RS row, two-stitch selvage, 1 st in St st, 1 st in rev St st, skp; at end of RS row, work to last 6 sts, k2tog, 1 st in rev St st, 1 st in St st, two-stitch selvage.

**Gauge:** 10 sts and 16 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 8 mm needles.

**Back:** With size 7 mm needles cast on 60 (64, 68) sts. Working first and last st as selvage sts, work in rib patt until piece meas 10 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 8 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st until piece meas 24 cm from cast-on. Place marker in first and last st on last WS row to indicate beg of armholes. Cont until piece meas 24 (25, 26) cm from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 5 (5, 6) sts 1 time, then 5 sts 2 times, 6 sts 1 time (then 6 sts 3 times / then 6 sts 2 times, 7 sts 1 time). At same time, when piece meas 2 cm from beg of shoulder shaping, shape neck as foll: Next row (RS): Bind off center 12 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 1 st 1 time. No sts rem.

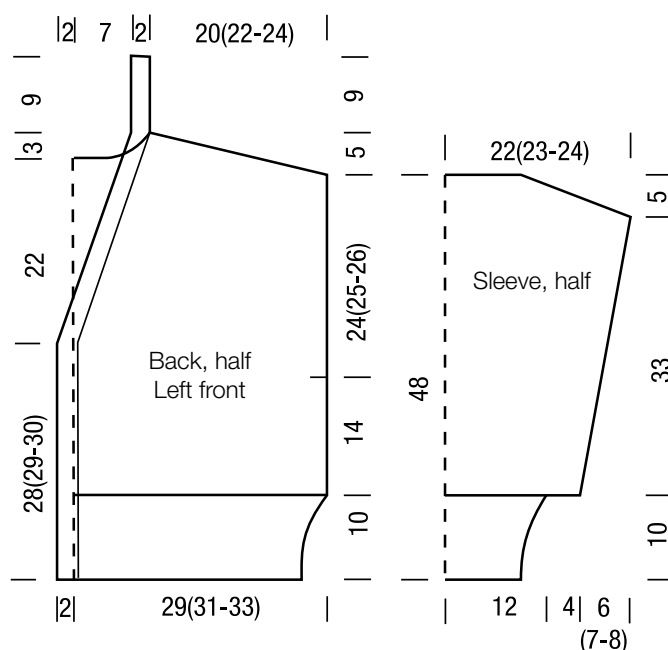
**Left front:** With size 7 mm needles cast on 34 (36, 38) sts. Next row (RS): Selvage st, work in rib patt to last 2 sts, two-stitch selvage. Work in patt as set by last row until piece meas 10 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 8 mm needles. Next row (RS): Selvage st, 29 (31, 33) sts in St st, 1 st in rev St st, 1 st in St st, two-stitch selvage. Work in patt as set by last row until piece meas 24 cm from cast-on. Place marker in last st on last WS row to indicate beg of armhole. Cont until piece meas 28 (29, 30) cm from cast-on,

ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at end of next RS row, then every 4th row 7 times, then every 6th row 1 time and when same length as back to shoulder, shape shoulder at right edge same as for back = 4 sts rem for neckband. Cast on 1 st at right edge of neckband (work as selvage st throughout) = 5 sts for neckband and cont in patt for 9 cm. Bind off all sts.

**Right front:** Work same as left front, reversing all shaping and patt placement and working 3 buttonholes at beg of RS rows as foll: Two-stitch selvage, bind off 2 sts, work to end. On foll WS row, cast on 2 sts over bound-off sts. Work first buttonhole when piece meas 3 cm from cast-on, rem 2 buttonholes spaced 12 (12.5, 13) cm apart.

**Sleeves:** With size 7 mm needles cast on 30 sts. Working first and last st as selvage sts, work in rib patt until piece meas 10 cm from cast-on, increasing 4 sts evenly across last WS row = 34 sts. Change to size 8 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at each end of 7 (9, 7)th row, then every 8th row 5 times (then every alt 6th and 8th row 4 times, then every 6th row 2 times / then every 6th row 7 times) = 46 (48, 50) sts. Work even until piece meas 43 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 5 sts at beg of next 6 rows, 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows (5 sts at beg of next 8 rows / 6 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 5 sts at beg of next 6 rows). Bind off rem 8 sts.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Sew bound-off edges of neckbands tog, then sew neckband to back neck. Sew on sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.



## Gauge Swatch

### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
