

LANA GROSSA



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SCARF
COOL WOOL DUETTO

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Size approx. 26 x 171 cm

Materials: 150 g of Lana Grossa **Cool Wool Duetto** (100% superfine Merino wool; 160 m/50 g) in Cream/Camel/Chocolate/Blue/Light Blue (**col 7503**) and 50 g each of Lana Grossa **Ecopuno** (72% cotton, 17% Merino wool, 11% baby alpaca; 215 m/50 g) in Brown Red (**col 31**) and Midnight Blue (**col 43**). Size 5 mm circular needle, 60 cm long.

2-color brioche rib: Multiple of 2 + 1. Work according to chart. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows, numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows. 2 RS rows and 2 WS rows are worked successively. Work RS row 1 with Cool Wool Duetto, do not turn work, sl sts to other end of circular needle. Work RS row 2 with Ecopuno. Work WS row 3 with Cool Wool Duetto, do not turn work, sl sts to other end of circular needle. Work WS row 4 with Ecopuno. Work rows 1 and 2 once, then rep rows 3 – 6. **Note:** 1 stitch and 1 yo are treated as 1 stitch.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1. **Note:** On rows worked with Cool Wool Duetto work two-stitch selvage as instructed; on rows worked with Ecopuno, simply slip the two selvage sts.

Gauge: 23 sts and 38 rows = 10 x 10 cm in 2-col brioche rib on size 5 mm needles.

Scarf: With size 5 mm circular needle and Cool Wool Duetto cast on 63 sts. Work in 2-col brioche rib according to chart. Work with Ecopuno col 43 first until ball is used up, then work with Ecopuno col 31 until ball is used up. Bind off all sts in patt.

Finishing: Pin piece to measurements and block. Carefully weave in all ends.





Chart key:

- = k1
- ⊙ = make a yo, then sl next st pwise
- ⊗ = ktog slipped st with its yo
- = ptog slipped st with its yo
- = Cool Wool Duetto
- = Ecopuno

Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.

beg = begin(ning) · **ch** = chain · **cont** = continue · **dec** = decompas(e)(ing) · **inc** = increas(e)(ing) · **k** = knit · **kwise** = as if to knit
meas = measures · **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop · **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop · **patt** = pattern · **pm** = place marker · **p** = purl
pwise = as if to purl · **rem** = remain(ing) · **rep** = repeat(s) · **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch · **rnd(s)** = round(s) · **RS** = right side · **sc** = single crochet · **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch · **sl** = slip · **st(s)** = stitch(es) · **St st** = stockinette stitch · **tbl** = through the back loop · **tog** = together · **wyib** = with yarn in back of work · **wyif** = with yarn in front of work · **WS** = wrong side · **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
