

AFGHAN · ALTA MODA CASHMERE 16

Design 65 from Filati Home 70

Approx. 174 cm long x 140 cm wide

Materials: 1300 g of Lana Grossa Alta Moda Cashmere 16 (78% Merino wool, 12% cashmere, 10% polyamide; 110 m/50 g) in Petrol (col 9). Size 7 mm circular needle, 120 cm long; cable needle [cn].

Slip garter selvage: On every row: Sl first st kwise, k last st.

Aran patt: Work according to chart. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate

RS rows, numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows. Position sts and rows as given in instructions.

Gauge: 17.5 sts and 20.5 rows = 10 x 10 cm in Aran patt on size 7 mm needles

Instructions: With size 7 mm circular needle cast on 246 sts. Next RS row: Work row 1 of Aran patt chart as foll: Work 6 sts to patt rep, work 42-st patt rep between arrows 5 times, end with 30 sts after patt rep. Cont to foll chart

through row 38, then work rows [1-38]8 times more = 342 rows total. Work rows 343 - 354 of chart once. Piece meas approx. 174 cm from cast-on and 354 chart rows have been worked. Loosely bind off all sts in patt and <u>at same time</u>, work cable crossings during bind-off as shown at top of chart and omit working yos.

Finishing: Pin piece to measurements and block. Carefully weave in all ends.



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


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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
