


EYEWEAR CORD





 **Materials:** Lana Grossa Cool Wool (100% superfine Merino wool; 160 m/50 g) total: 8g

- approx. 1g **Natural** (col 590),
- approx. 1g **Moss Green** (col 2086),
- approx. 1g **Camel** (col 2092),
- approx. 1g **Salmon** (col 2095),
- approx. 1g **Mocha** (col 2074),
- approx. 1g **Safran** (col 2065),
- approx. 1g **Cobalt Blue** (col 555) and
- approx. 1g **Dark Violet** (col 2023);

1 knitting spool + needle by Lana Grossa

2 silicon rings

1 tapestry needle by Lana Grossa (not included in the set).

 **Size:** approx. 90 cm long



Note:
1 m of yarn
makes approx.
5 cm of cord.

Stripe patt:

5 cm with 1 strand Mocha,
5 cm with 1 strand **Cobalt Blue**,
5 cm with 1 strand **Natural**,
5 cm with 1 strand **Salmon**,
5 cm with 1 strand **Safran**,
5 cm with 1 strand **Dark Violet**
5 cm with 1 strand **Camel**,
5 cm with 1 strand **Moss Green**,
5 cm with 1 strand Mocha,
5 cm with 1 strand **Cobalt Blue**,
5 cm with 1 strand **Natural**,
5 cm with 1 strand **Salmon**,
5 cm with 1 strand **Safran**,
5 cm with 1 strand **Dark Violet**
5 cm with 1 strand **Camel**,
5 cm with 1 strand **Moss Green**,
5 cm with 1 strand Mocha, and
5 cm with 1 strand **Cobalt Blue**.

= 90 cm total.

Eyewear Cord:

Using colors as desired, cut single strands of yarn in desired lengths; firmly knot lengths tog. For detailed instruction, refer to illustrations and photos in the spool knitting lesson.

Thread the yarn through your spool knitter from top to bottom.

Hold yarn tail coming out from bottom with your left hand.

Using your right hand, wind yarn around first pin in a counterclockwise direction (see 1).

Wrap in same fashion around remaining 3 pins.

After all 4 pins have been wrapped this way, wrap the yarn around the outside of the first pin.

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Using the needle, lift the bottom stitch over the top of the pin (see 2) and over the yarn wound around the outside of the pin.

Pull yarn tail at the bottom. Wrap yarn around outside of next pin and repeat from

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around each pin – 4 sts have been formed and first round has been completed. Repeat round 1 throughout.

After having worked a few rounds, the cord starts filling the opening at the top (see 3).

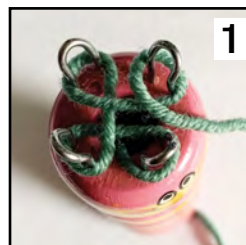
Keep pulling the yarn tail at the bottom tight; the finished cord will slowly appear through the bottom.

After the cord has the required length, cut the working yarn, leaving a long tail.

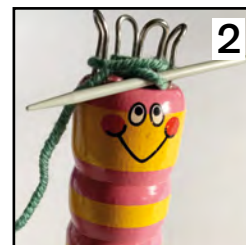
Thread the tapestry needle (not included in the set) with the yarn tail thread through loop on first pin, lift off pin and thread yarn through loop (see 4).

Repeat for remaining loops (see 5). Pull stitches tight (see 6).

Remove cord from spool knitter. Knot ends to silicon rings.



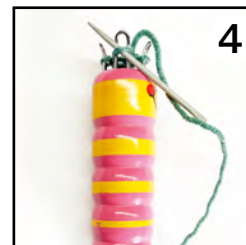
wind yarn

lift stitch over pin



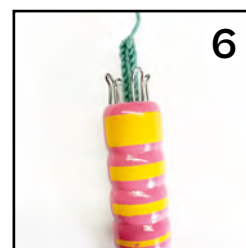
opening starts filling
