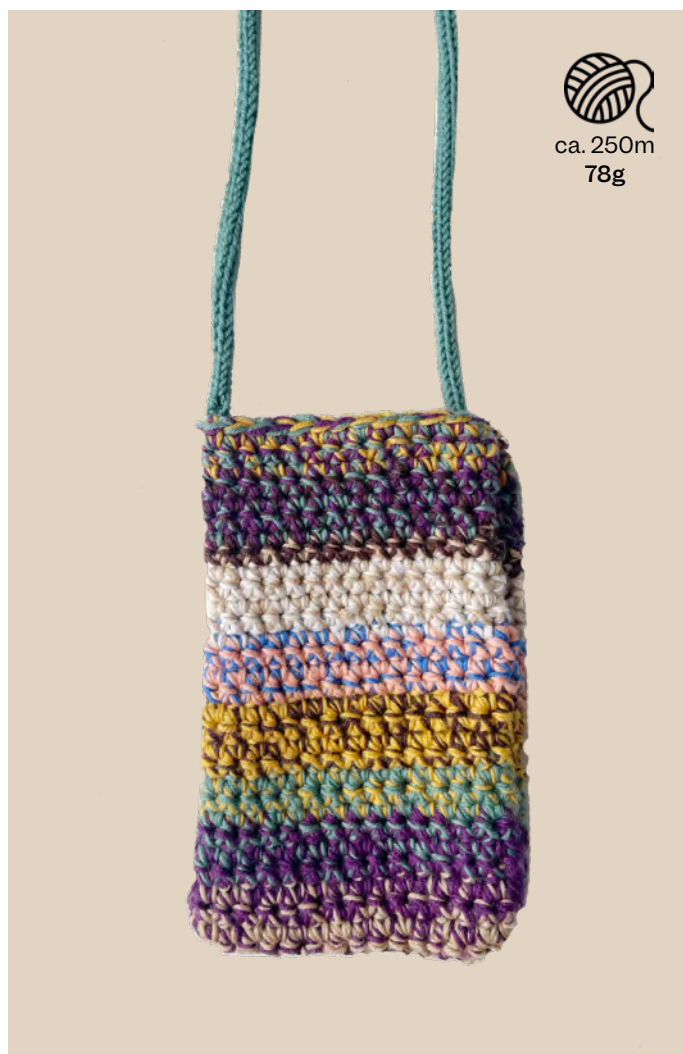


# SHOULDER BAG





ca. 250m  
78g



**Materials:** Lana Grossa Cool Wool (100% superfine Merino wool; 160 m/50 g); total 78g

- approx. 9,75g **Natural** (col 590),
- approx. 9,75g **Moss Green** (col 2086),
- approx. 9,75g **Camel** (col 2092),
- approx. 9,75g **Salmon** (col 2095),
- approx. 9,75g **Mocha** (col 2074),
- approx. 9,75g **Safran** (col 2065),
- approx. 9,75g **Cobalt Blue** (col 555) and
- approx. 9,75g **Dark Violet** (col 2023);

Size 6 mm crochet hook by Lana Grossa

1 knitting spool + needle by Lana Grossa

1 tapestry needle by Lana Grossa (not included in the set).



**Sizes:**

Bag: 12,5 cm wide, 20 cm long (without cord)

Cord as lanyard: approx. 110 cm long



**Gauge:** 14 sc and 14.5 rnds = 10 x 10 cm with size 6 mm hook and 3 strands held tog.



**Single crochet [sc]:** Work in continuous rnds without joining. Place marker to indicate beg of rnds. Move marker up as work progresses.

#### Stripe patt:

2 rnds with 2 strands **Camel** and 1 strand **Dark Violet**,  
 2 rnds with 1 strand **Camel** and 2 strands **Dark Violet**,  
 3 rnds with 2 strands **Dark Violet** and 1 strand **Moss Green**,  
 3 rnds with 2 strands **Moss Green** and 1 strand **Safran**,  
 4 rnds with 2 strands **Safran** and 1 strand **Mocha**,  
 3 rnds with 2 strands **Salmon** and 1 strand **Cobalt Blue**,  
 1 rnd with 1 strand **Cobalt Blue** and 2 strands **Natural**,  
 4 rnds with 1 strand **Natural** and 2 strands **Camel**,  
 1 rnd with 2 strands **Mocha** and 1 strand **Camel**,  
 3 rnds with 1 strand **Mocha**, **Dark Violet** and **Moss Green**  
 3 rnds with 1 strand **Moss Green**, **Dark Violet** and **Safran**  
 = 29 rnds total.

**Bag:**

With size 6 mm hook and 2 strands **Camel** and 1 strand **Dark Violet** held tog, ch 34 (see 1 and 2).

Slip st into first ch to form a ring (see 3).

Work sc in continuous rnds and follow stripe patt (see 4 and 5).

When changing color(s) at beg of rnd, leave a 7 cm long tail of new color(s) on wrong side of work.

Photo 6 shows hook inserted in a sc stitch on previous rnd.

Photo 7 shows hook and wrapped yarn ready to complete the sc stitch.

Photo 8 shows hook wrapped with new color(s) ready to complete the sc stitch.

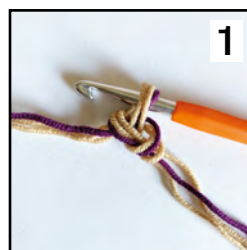
Work to end of stripe patt = 29 rnds and piece meas 20 cm from beg (see 9).

Cut yarn and fasten off last st (see 10).

Carefully weave in all ends (see 11).

The finished case (see 12).

**Note:** To change color(s), work to last yarn over in old color(s), pick up new color(s) and complete st with new color(s).



Slip knot



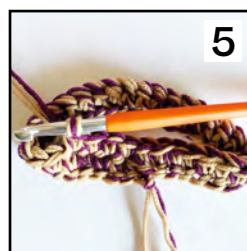
Slip st into first ch



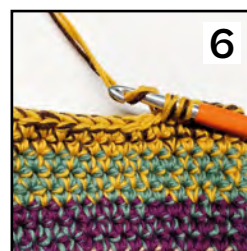
to form a ring



2 single crochet sts



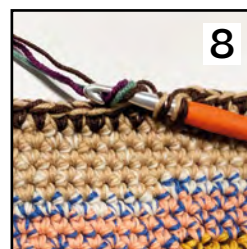
beginning of 2nd rnd



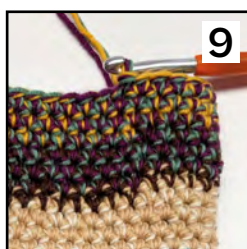
insert hook to work sc



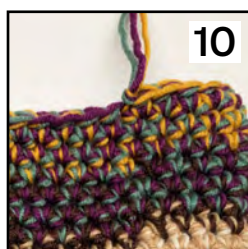
several rnds have been worked



color change/beg of rnds



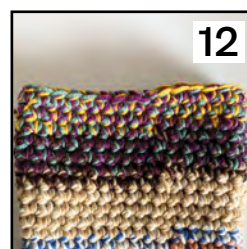
last stitch

### Finishing:

Thread tapestry needle with 2 strands **Camel**. Close bottom seam with whipstitch (see 13 and 14).

Turn case inside out, knot yarn ends (see 15).

Carefully weave in all ends (see 16).

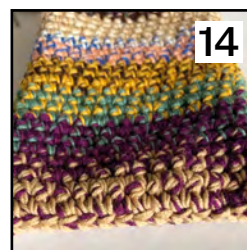
Photo 17 shows inside of case after all ends have been woven in.

Turn case to right side (see 18).

Sew on cord (see 19 and 20).



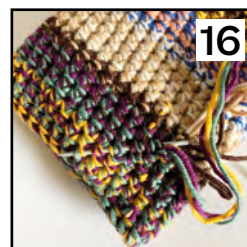
close bottom seam



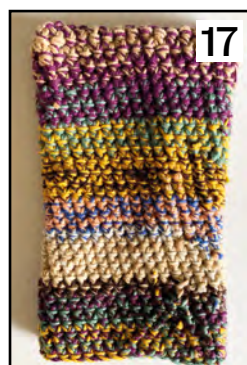
closed seam



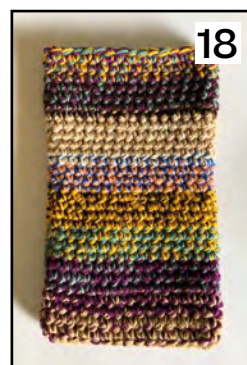
knot yarn ends

### Cord:

Worked with single strand **Moss Green**.

For detailed instruction, refer to illustrations and photos in the spool knitting lesson.

Thread the yarn through your spool knitter from top to bottom.

Hold yarn tail coming out from bottom with your left hand.

Using your right hand, wind yarn around first pin in a counterclockwise direction.

Wrap in same fashion around remaining 3 pins.

After all 4 pins have been wrapped this way, wrap the yarn around the outside of the first pin.

Using the needle, lift the bottom stitch over the top of the pin and over the yarn wound around the outside of the pin.

Pull yarn tail at the bottom.

Wrap yarn around outside of next pin and repeat from

around each pin – 4 sts have been formed and first round has been completed.

Repeat round 1 throughout.

After having worked a few rounds, the cord starts filling the opening at the top.

Keep pulling the yarn tail at the bottom tight; the finished cord will slowly appear through the bottom.

After the cord has the required length, cut the working yarn, leaving a long tail.

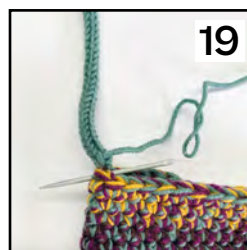
Thread the tapestry needle with the yarn tail (see 17), thread through loop on first pin, lift off pin and thread yarn through loop.

Repeat for remaining loops.

Pull stitches tight.

Remove cord from spool knitter.

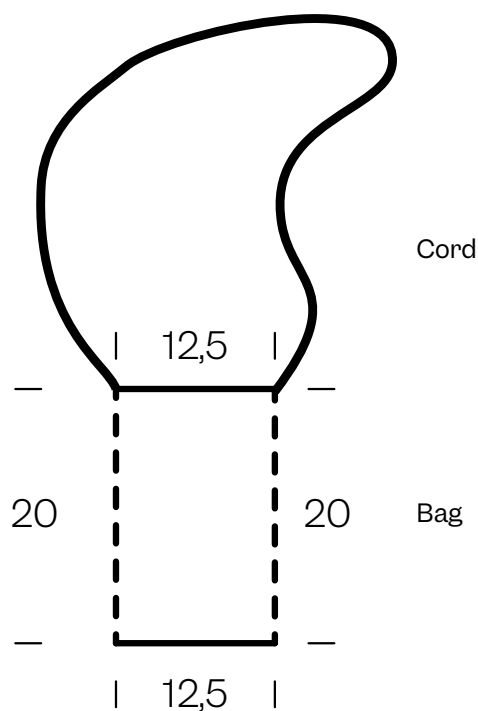
Sew cord to glasses case (see 19) .
